TEXT: Hebrews 3:1-6

## **Hebrews 3:1-6**

**1** *Therefore, holy brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the Apostle and High Priest of our confession, Christ Jesus,*

**2** *who was faithful to Him who appointed Him, as Moses also was faithful in all His house.*

**3** *For this One has been counted worthy of more glory than Moses, inasmuch as He who built the house has more honor than the house.*

**4** *For every house is built by someone, but He who built all things is God.*

**5** *And Moses indeed was faithful in all His house as a servant, for a testimony of those things which would be spoken afterward,*

**6** *but Christ as a Son over His own house, whose house we are if we hold fast the confidence and the rejoicing of the hope firm to the end.*

*“But when she could no longer hide him, she got a basket made of papyrus reeds and waterproofed it with tar and pitch. She put the baby in the basket and laid it among the reeds along the bank of the Nile River.” (Exodus 2:3 - NLT)*

## **Deuteronomy 34:1,4**

**1** *Then Moses went up to Mount Nebo from the plains of Moab and climbed Pisgah Peak, which is across from Jericho. And the Lord showed him the whole land ...*

**4** *Then the Lord said to Moses, “This is the land I promised on oath to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob ... I have now allowed you to see it with your own eyes, but you will not enter the land.” (NLT)*
